PROTECTIVE INSTRUMENT CASE ENDORSEMENT

This endorsement modifies insurance provided under the following:

MUSICAL INSTRUMENT SIGNATURE COVERAGE FORM

You agree to maintain the protective measure(s) or safeguard(s) described below for the duration of the Policy. This includes a 15% Loss Mitigation Credit, which applies to the insurance pricing for your Anderson Approved Protective Instrument Case, as well as the total insured value of the instrument(s) housed within the Approved Protective Instrument. This endorsement establishes a 15% Loss Mitigation Credit applicable to the insured pricing of musical instruments protected by an Approved Protective Instrument Case, as defined herein.

A. QUALIFICATION

To receive the 15% Loss Mitigation Credit, the insured must comply with the following conditions throughout the policy term:

1. Use of Approved Case

The instrument must be housed in the Anderson Approved Protective Instrument Case and model listed below.

2. Instrument Declaration

The insured must declare below any instrument(s) that will be housed and protected in the Approved Protective Instrument Case.

3. Itemization Requirements

- a. Manufacturer, Make and Model of the Approved Protective Instrument Case must be listed in the itemized schedule of instruments and accessories.
- b. Each assigned instrument must be clearly identified with the year, make, model, serial number and requested stated value.

4. Transport Safeguard Requirement

Any covered loss occurring during transport is subject to verification that the instrument was housed in the designated protective case at the time of loss.

B. LOSS MITIGATION CREDIT APPLICATION

The 15% Loss Mitigation Credit applies to the premium associated with the Anderson Approved Protective Instrument Case and the total stated value of the instrument(s) protected by the Approved Protective Instrument.
